



Child Student Visa

For children aged 4–17 studying at an independent school under the Child Student route.

How to use this checklist — Tick each item that applies to your case, then review the final evidence against the current UKVI requirements before submitting an application.

Identity & application

- ☐ Current passport; previous immigration documents where relevant; completed application and appointment details.

CAS & school

- ☐ CAS from the licensed independent school; school offer/admission evidence; evidence of course and boarding arrangements if applicable.

Parental consent

- ☐ Written consent from parent(s) or legal guardian; evidence of relationship such as birth/adoption documents; care arrangements.

Living arrangements

- ☐ Evidence of where the child will live; boarding confirmation or approved foster/private foster care arrangements where applicable.

Financial evidence

- ☐ Evidence of funds and/or sponsorship in the form permitted for the route; evidence of tuition and living costs where relevant.

TB / health

- ☐ TB certificate if required for an applicant applying from Pakistan; other health documents only where relevant.

Travel & welfare

- ☐ Travel arrangements, guardian/custody information and emergency contact details where appropriate.
