



Private Medical Treatment Visa

For eligible applicants travelling to the UK for private medical treatment.

How to use this checklist — Tick each item that applies to your case, then review the final evidence against the current UKVI requirements before submitting an application.

Identity & application

- ☐ Current passport; previous passports/immigration documents where relevant; completed application and appointment details.

Medical provider

- ☐ Letter from the UK private hospital/clinic confirming treatment, proposed dates, estimated cost and that the provider is willing to treat the applicant.

Treatment plan

- ☐ Medical reports or diagnosis from the treating doctor; proposed treatment plan and expected duration where appropriate.

Funding evidence

- ☐ Evidence that the applicant can pay for treatment, accommodation and living costs, including funds from an approved sponsor where applicable.

Accommodation & travel

- ☐ Accommodation arrangements and intended travel dates; evidence for any accompanying person where relevant.

Sponsor / accompanying person

- ☐ Identity and financial evidence for a person paying costs or accompanying the applicant, where applicable.

Previous medical travel

- ☐ Relevant previous UK treatment/immigration evidence if it helps explain the application.

Translations

- ☐ Appropriate English/Welsh translations for medical or financial documents not in English or Welsh, where required.
