



Student Visa

For applicants studying in the UK under the Student route.

How to use this checklist — Tick each item that applies to your case, then review the final evidence against the current UKVI requirements before submitting an application.

Identity & application

- ☐ Current passport; previous immigration documents where relevant; completed application and appointment details.

CAS & education

- ☐ CAS statement/reference from the licensed sponsor; academic certificates/transcripts used by the sponsor; ATAS certificate if applicable.

Financial evidence

- ☐ Required tuition/living funds evidence in the permitted form; bank statements or other accepted evidence; evidence covering the required period where applicable.

English language

- ☐ Evidence of English language ability where required by the route and sponsor.

Fees & sponsorship

- ☐ Tuition fee payment evidence where relevant; scholarship/sponsorship letter if funded by an organisation.

TB / medical

- ☐ TB test certificate if required for an applicant applying from Pakistan; additional medical evidence only where relevant to the route.

Under 18 / dependants

- ☐ Parental consent and birth/custody evidence for applicants under 18; dependant documents only if the route permits dependants.

Important: This checklist is a practical planning aid, not legal advice and not a guarantee of a visa outcome. UKVI requirements can change and the documents needed depend on the applicant's circumstances. Always check the current official requirements before applying. Documents not in English or Welsh may require appropriate translation.
