



Family Visa Checklist

Covers Spouse/Partner, Fiancé(e), Parent, Child and Adult Dependent Relative visas.

Eligibility at a Glance

- A genuine and subsisting relationship with a British citizen or settled person (or the qualifying relationship itself, for Parent/Child)
- The UK-based sponsor meets the minimum financial requirement set by the Home Office
- Adequate accommodation without recourse to public funds
- Meet the relevant English language requirement
- (Adult Dependent Relative) evidence that long-term care is not available or affordable in Pakistan

Document Checklist

- Valid passport
- Marriage/civil partnership certificate, or evidence of a genuine relationship (Spouse/Partner and Fiancé(e) routes)
- Evidence meeting the financial requirement (payslips, employment letter, bank statements or savings)
- Proof of suitable accommodation in the UK
- English language test certificate
- Birth certificates proving the relationship (Parent/Child routes)
- Medical evidence of the required level of care from a doctor (Adult Dependent Relative route)

- Evidence that adequate care is unavailable in the home country (Adult Dependent Relative route)
- Tuberculosis test certificate, where applicable
